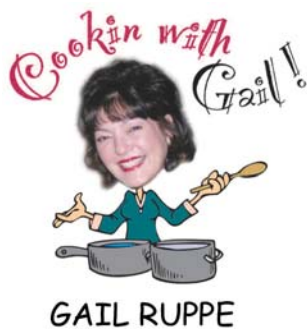

Family Favorite Lemon Cake

- 1 (18.25 oz) Betty Crocker lemon cake mix
- 1 (14 oz) can Eagle Brand sweetened condensed milk
- 1 (3.4 oz) box instant lemon pudding mix
- 1 (8 oz) container Cool Whip, thawed

Heat oven to 350, lightly grease and flour bottom of 13 x 9 inch baking dish

Mix cake mix according to package directions. Pour into prepared pan and bake 25 to 30 minutes or until tests done. Allow cake to cool about 5 minutes. Poke holes with spoon handle; pour Eagle Brand over top of warm cake. Allow to cool completely. Mix pudding according to package directions and pour over top of cake. Top with Cool Whip. Keep refrigerated.
